

2023 International Conference on Applied Electronics (AE 2023)

University of West Bohemia, Pilsen, Czech Republic, 6 to 8 September 2023

The 28th International Conference on Applied Electronics is the latest regular event organized yearly from 1996 by the University of West Bohemia in Pilsen, Czech Republic. The aim is to provide a forum for researchers and practitioners interested in advances in the wide scope of electronic circuits and systems, especially in applications of theoretical research. The AE conferences are sponsored by IEEE - Industrial Electronics Society and IEEE - Czechoslovakia Section.

All the papers are peer-to-peer reviewed for acceptance by the International Program Committee, composed of respected experts. The AE Proceedings will be submitted to IEEE Xplore, ISI Web of Knowledge, and Scopus databases. Conference language is English. All papers will be checked for plagiarism.

- Automotive electronics, issues of safety
- Bio-Medical electronics
- Electronics in industry, EMC
- Electronics in measurement and control
- Electronic systems simulation and CAD
- Electronics in telecommunications, IoT

- Signal processing
- ... and other related areas

The papers should report original work and applied ideas, including experimental results.

All papers have to be presented at the conference; the organizers reserve the right to exclude a paper from distribution after the conference if the paper is not presented at the conference. Each paper must be presented by its author; no substitutions will be allowed. Each author can submit at most two papers.

Conference venue:
